Dial +1 (650) 963-0030. When prompted, enter the 8-digit conference ID. The WebEx Telepresence bridge service supports inbound calls only from WebEx Telepresence devices, standards-based H.323/SIP video devices, and PSTN calling parties. The WebEx Telepresence bridge service does not offer dial-out capability.

Cisco Webex Telepresence is SIP URI based service, however, the infrastructure will allow H.323 calls based on the link I provided regarding root CAs. This setup may still be needed to call into the bridge regardless of protocol. On the other hand, if you are using the SIP URI configuration your setup may work.

A Cisco WebEx Telepresence bridge is accessible by any video user with a compatible SIP or H.323 standards- compliant video device that can dial a URI on the public Internet. Thus customers (whether or not they have WebEx Telepresence device subscriptions) can subscribe to this service and enable collaboration across a broad community of users.

WebEx Telepresence allows participants in WebEx meetings to connect via video with participants using Telepresence video conferencing endpoints (traditional H.323 and SIP videoconferencing). Standard room based videoconferencing systems use H.323 or SIP as the protocol to connect rooms and control the call.

Standalone endpoints can connect to WebEx Meeting Center, but they must use H323, as SIP isn't supported. The SX10 supports H323 with CR8.2 and later software. Nothing special is required to be configured on the endpoint, but it must be able to contact DNS to lookup the domain of the WebEx URI being dialed, you should take a look at the WebEx ...
